Section A - PERSONAL DATA and APPLICATION FEES

Complete Section A in full.

All applicants must enclose a re-application fee of \$39.00. The fee is non-refundable and should be made payable to The University of British Columbia by **VISA, MasterCard, money order or certified cheque in Canadian funds. If paying in person, cash is also accepted. Personal cheques are not accepted.** Applications will not be processed unless the appropriate application fees have been paid.

Section B - CITIZENSHIP OR IMMIGRATION STATUS

Complete Section B in full.

Permanent residents (landed immigrants) must provide proof of immigration.

Section C - BACHELOR OF EDUCATION PROGRAM OPTIONS *Indicate to which program option(s) you are applying for admission.*

An applicant indicates the program option to which he/she is seeking re-admission. If re-applying for the middle years option or the secondary option, indicate the specialization or the teaching field(s) of a respective option.
