**Admission Average Calculation**

A minimum average of 65% (2.5 on a 4 point scale) is required to be eligible for admission consideration.

**Notes:**

- Courses that fulfill the English language requirement include those focusing on the history of structure of English, rhetorical theory, or approaches to discourse. Students with deficiencies in this area may be considered for admission if they have a high academic standing and significant additional English coursework beyond the minimum 30 credits (e.g., a BA Honours or MA in English).
- It is **recommended** that prospective English Education applicants have completed courses in Canadian literature and composition.
