Breadth of coverage for Theatre Education

Coursework might include a variety of courses in the following areas:

- a. acting (ie: THTR 271, 272, 273)
- b. directing (ie: THTR 317) (see Note 2)
- c. theatrical production (ie: THTR 299)
- d. history of theatre (THTR 320)
- e. theatre education
- f. theatre studies

Admission Average Calculation

A minimum average of 65% (2.5 on a 4 point scale) is required to be eligible for admission consideration.
