





3. A French Immersion secondary option is available for applicants wishing to teach one or more of the following subject content areas in French: biology, chemistry, earth science, physics, history, geography, social science, and mathematics.
4. A degree in translation does not normally satisfy the admission requirements unless the above requirements are met.
5. Applicants whose first language is French and who completed a degree in a French-language university in a country or a province where French is the principal language should consult the Teacher Education Office about their French course requirements.
