Notes:

1. An applicant presenting a modern language as a teachable subject must also prepare for a second teachable subject in a [subject area widely taught in BC secondary schools](#).
2. Applicants will be required to demonstrate oral and written proficiency in their selected language(s) either prior to admission or early in the program.
3. Applicants whose first language is one of the modern languages listed here and who completed a degree in a country where the language is the principal language may consult the Teacher Education Office at the UBC Faculty of Education about their language course requirements for admission.
4. If admitted, an applicant presenting German should expect his/her practicum placement to be in a secondary school in Surrey or east of Surrey.
5. If admitted, an applicant presenting Russian should expect to undertake his/her practicum in the West Kootenay area.
6. In the event that a practicum placement for Korean is not possible, the applicant would undertake his/her practicum only in the second teachable subject. Practicum placements may only be available on weekends. (This provision is necessary because at present, Korean is not taught in BC secondary schools).
7. The French immersion option is not available for Modern Languages.
