- 5. Business Arising from Minutes
 - Welcome the new member Dr. Stephanie Glick (EDST Representative)-Tabled
 - Update on calendar proofreading
 - The calendar update was discussed and proposed changes for 2022-2023 were reviewed.
 - o It was confirmed that all accepted changes have been addressed
 - During the review process, two minor points were identified for further consideration that will be going over in new business.
 - o A summary memo regarding the calendar update will be circulated soon.
 - Each department has been requested to provide feedback on the proposed changes to ensure alignment with their respective needs.

6. New Business

EDCP 493 Curriculum Proposal Change

- The proposed change aims to expand the course from 3 to 12 credits to 4 separate EDCP 493X courses, allowing for greater flexibility in course offerings under food studies.
- Discussion took place regarding the delivery format of the course and its implications for student enrollment.
- The existing CAT 2 will be edited and revised, and then presented at the next CCASA meeting.

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- CAT 2 change for EDUC 440 (plus attachment);
 - Changing the title of Aboriginal Education in Canada into Indigenous Education to align it more closely with widely used terminology in the field.
 - o This change was not included in the Calendar changes from the previous calendar year, so needs to be approved at this time
 - CARRIED (contingent on Stephanie's approval)
- Review of Calendar changes for EDCP 312 and 313
 - There was a discrepancy between the proposed language for prerequisites and what could be implemented in Work Day.
 - A detailed explanation was provided regarding the rationale behind the language choice and the challenges posed by the current structure.
 - Several suggestions were made to address the issue, including exploring linguistic and programming options.
 - o It was acknowledged that further communication with the Senate would be necessary to resolve the issue.
